

## Information Pack 2018

### REGISTRATION

**Online registration** opens on **January 18th 2018**. Players can register and pay online without the need to attend a sign-on venue.

You will only be required to attend a Sign-on/Information day if you wish to use Pysmart.

**Sign-on / Information days** will be held at Cooroy Library, 9.30am – 12:30pm Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> January 2018 and Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2018. Computers and assistance will be available for registering online, and socks and shorts will be available for purchase.

**Birth Certificate/Identification** – all new players are required to provide Birth Certificate (for Juniors) or photo identification (for Seniors). These can be sighted at Sign-on/Information Days or emailed to the Registrar at [cufcregistrar2@gmail.com](mailto:cufcregistrar2@gmail.com).

All players, coaches, managers, and volunteers in 2018 **must self-register** on MyFootballClub.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Registration does not **guarantee** a place in a team; it is simply an expression of interest on which team selections are based. Obviously early registrations have an advantage.

Preference will be given to returning 2017 players until midnight second sign-on day, 3<sup>rd</sup> February.

## FEES

**Fee schedule** is attached. Please note that registrations on or before 3<sup>rd</sup> February attract a **\$15.00 discount**. This is to encourage timely registration. The Committee has to nominate teams for the Sunshine Coast Football (SCF) competition by February 16<sup>th</sup> - late registrations can cause considerable problems including delays in team allocation and delays to start of training. **Paysmart** – is a payment plan service and is available for those not able to pay full fees up front. We do not offer in-house payment plans. Paysmart can be used for full fees or part fees, including the gap between Get Started Voucher value (\$150.00) and full fee. Paysmart start date can be delayed with committee member approval to help ease budget pressures. A signed Paysmart arrangement is considered payment in full regardless of instalment start date. To use Paysmart you will need to attend a sign-on venue to complete the appropriate paperwork. You will need to provide your bank account name, BSB, and account number.

**Get Started** – is a Queensland Government support programme to assist in the affordability of sporting club fees for children 5 to under the age of 18. This programme is available to parents, carers, and guardians who hold a Centrelink Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession card, or those identified by two referral agents. Eligible children and young people are presented with a voucher that provides up to \$150 to help with the costs for membership and participation fees. ## **TEAM PREFERENCES**

All players are encouraged to play in their own age group as set out in the SCF Player Age Policy and the 2018 Player Age Eligibility. **Players will only be able to register in their own age group** on MyFootballClub; however consideration will be given to requests to play outside of this age group. Any team preference requests (including team preferences within own age group) must be submitted before midday 3<sup>rd</sup> February at sign-on or by email to [cufcregistrar2@gmail.com](mailto:cufcregistrar2@gmail.com). Although every effort will be made to meet requests for particular team allocations, the committee is unable to guarantee such requests will be met. The Committee will be allocating players to teams, based on those registered at the time, immediately after second sign-on/information day, 3<sup>rd</sup> February. Team preferences after 3<sup>rd</sup> February will only be considered if already formed teams are not affected.

## **EQUIPMENT REQUIRED**

**MiniRoos** wear black shorts, blue socks. **Competitive** teams wear navy shorts, navy socks.

**Socks and shorts** for juniors will be available at sign-on / information days. After this date we will advise when available subject to volunteer availability to handle sales. Please email Emma, at [cufctreasurer@gmail.com](mailto:cufctreasurer@gmail.com) if you can help with socks and shorts sales on your training day. Socks are \$15, shorts \$25.

**Player jerseys** are provided by the Club in team kits looked after by the team manager.

**Boots and shin pads** are required for training and games; Sports Power Noosa is the preferred provider – mention CUFC to receive a 10% discount on soccer boots and clothing.

## **TRAINING**

**Training commences** as soon as teams are formed and coaches are ready to go. Training days are dependent on Coach availability. Managers will contact players advising them of training times.

## **Team numbers**

**U6/7 teams** play 4-a-side with no goalkeeper, maximum of 3 substitutes.

**U8/9 teams** play 7-a-side, including goal keeper, maximum of 4 substitutes.

**U10/11 teams** play 9-a-side, including goalkeeper, maximum of 5 substitutes.

**U12 teams** play 9-a-side, including goalkeeper, maximum of 5 substitutes.

**U13 to Senior teams** have eleven players, including goalkeeper, maximum of 5 substitutes.

## **Rescheduled Matches i.e. Washed out games**

Re-schedules due to wet weather will take place as follows:

1. Friday night matches to the following Tuesday night
2. Saturday Senior matches to the following Wednesday night
3. Saturday Junior matches - U15 Boys, U15 Girls and U17 Boys junior matches to mid week
4. Saturday junior matches - Under 12, Under 13 Boys, Under 13 Girls and Under 14 to Sunday week
5. U10/11s **Kangaroos** matches to Sunday week

All competitive matches must be re-scheduled and played. In the first instance Under 10 Kangaroos and Under 11 Kangaroos will be re-scheduled and must be played, however if the match is required to be re-scheduled a second time clubs can apply for the match not to be played.

## **INSURANCE**

Player insurance is included in the FQ component of player fees. The insurance plan provides basic levels of cover for players and others participating in Football, but is not all encompassing and does not seek to replace the need for private health and other insurances. All players and officials are encouraged to take out their own private health insurance, life insurance and 'Top Up' coverage over and above the coverage provided under this plan.

## Cooroora United Football Club Self-Registration Guide

Please follow the following instructions to register online for our club:

### 1. Login:

- a) Go to the MyFootballClub website: <https://www.playfootball.com.au/>
- b) Click on “Register Now”
- c) Follow the prompts to proceed to login pages, find your FFA number and/or reset your password
- d) Login using your FFA number and password:

### 2. Start Registration

- a) Once logged in, select “Make a Registration” or “Register Now”
- b) Update contact details if necessary.
- c) On the next screen, enter the club name Cooroora United Football Club  
***NB: If you get a message saying there are no packages then click OK and check the club name***
- d) Select the Registration role as: “Player”  
***NB: If this is the first time you have registered to play football in Australia you will need to confirm whether you played in another country***
- e) Select the correct Registration Package that applies for your registration.
- f) Click the “Add” button.
- g) Click the Next button at the bottom of the screen.
- h) Read and acknowledge the Terms and Conditions then click Next.
- i) Click on “Pay Now” to pay online with a credit card (VISA or MasterCard), or select “Manual Payment at Club” if you want to pay at our club information day, via bank transfer, or to apply for Pysmart.  
***NB: Payment must be made before a registration can be accepted.***
- j) Answer the questions on the final page and click the “Save All Answers” button.

Your registration has now been submitted. Make sure you have paid your fees and completed any necessary ID checks, etc.
