REGISTRATION

Online registration opens on January 9th 2017. Players can register and pay online without the need to attend a sign-on venue.

You will only be required to attend a Sign-on/Information day if you wish to use Paymart.

Sign-on / Information days will be held at Cooroy Library, 9.00am – 12md Saturday 21st January 2017 and Saturday 28th January 2017. Computers and assistance will be available for registering online, and socks and shorts will be available for purchase.

Birth Certificate/Identification – all new players are required to provide Birth Certificate (for Juniors) or photo identification (for Seniors). These can be sighted at Sign-on/Information Days or emailed to the Registrar at cufcregistrar2@gmail.com.

All players, coaches, managers, and volunteers in 2017 must self-register on MyFootballClub.

PLEASE NOTE: Registration does not **guarantee** a place in a team; it is simply an expression of interest on which team selections are based. Obviously early registrations have an advantage. Preference will be given to returning 2016 players until midnight second sign-on day, 28th January.

FEES

Fee schedule is attached. Please note that registrations on or before 28th January attract a **\$15.00 discount**. This is to encourage timely registration. The Committee has to nominate teams for the Sunshine Coast Football (SCF) competition by February 17th - late registrations can cause considerable problems including delays in team allocation and delays to start of training. PAYMENT OPTIONS

Online – full payment can be made by credit card at the time of registration.

Paysmart – is a payment plan service and is available for those not able to pay full fees up front. We do not offer in-house payment plans. Paysmart can be used for full fees or part fees, including the gap between Get Started Voucher value (\$150.00) and full fee. Paysmart start date can be delayed with committee member approval to help ease budget pressures. A signed Paysmart arrangement is considered payment in full regardless of instalment start date. To use Paysmart you will need to attend a sign-on venue to complete the appropriate paperwork. You will need to provide your bank account name, BSB, and account number.

Get Started – is a Queensland Government support programme to assist in the affordability of sporting club fees for children 5 to under the age of 18. This programme is available to parents, carers, and guardians who hold a Centrelink Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession card, or those identified by two referral agents. Eligible children and young people are presented with a voucher that provides up to \$150 to help with the costs for membership and participation fees. TEAM PREFERENCES

All players are encouraged to play in their own age group as set out in the SCF Player Age Policy and the 2017 Player Age Eligibility. Players will only be able to register in their own age group on MyFootballClub; however consideration will be given to requests to play outside of this age group. Any team preference requests (including team preferences within own age group) must be submitted before midday 28th January at sign-on or by email to cufcregistrar2@gmail.com. Although every effort will be made to meet requests for particular team allocations, the committee is unable to guarantee such requests will be met. The Committee will be allocating players to teams, based on those registered at the time, immediately after second sign-on/information day, 28th January. Team preferences after 28th January will only be considered if already formed teams are not affected.

EQUIPMENT REQUIRED

CUFC socks and shorts for juniors will be available at sign-on / information days. After this date we will advise when available subject to volunteer availability to handle sales. Please email Emma, at cufctreasurer@gmail.com if you could help with socks and shorts sales on your training day. Socks are \$15, shorts \$25.

Player jerseys are provided by the Club in team kits looked after by the team manager.

Boots and shin pads are required for training and games; Sports Power Noosa is the preferred provider – mention CUFC to receive a 10% discount on soccer boots and clothing.

TRAINING

Training commences as soon as teams are formed and coaches are ready to go. Training days are dependent on Coach availability. Managers will contact players advising them of training times.

GAME DAY INFORMATION

For an overview of the season dates for your playing division please see the Sunshine Coast Football Yearly Planner.

All game day information (including fixtures, times, venues, wet weather information, contacts) can be found on the **Cooroora United Football Club App**, available to download from the App Store or Google Play.

Game venues: vary depending on team/division/draw. All draws are determined by Sunshine Coast Football. Games/carnivals may be held at any club within SCF.

Rescheduled Matches i.e. Washed out games.

Friday night washed out games are typically rescheduled to the following Tuesday night.

Saturday washed out games are typically rescheduled to the Sunday of the following weekend.

Team numbers:

U6/7 teams have four players plus reserves, ideally five or six in team.

U8/9 teams have seven players, including goaly, plus reserves, ideally nine or ten in team.

U10/11 teams have nine players, including goaly, plus reserves, ideally eleven to thirteen in team.

U11/12 Girls teams play 9-a-side on a half field, with a maximum of 14 players.

U12 to U18 teams have eleven players, including goaly, and a maximum five reserves.

Player insurance is provided by Football Queensland, cost is included in the FQ component of player fees.

Cooroora United Football Club Self-Registration Guide

Please follow the following instructions to register online for our club:

1. Login:

- a) Go to the MyFootballClub website: www.myfootballclub.com.au
- b) Click on “Register Now”
- c) Select “Player Registration”
- d) Follow the prompts to proceed to login pages, find your FFA number and/or reset your password
- e) Login using your FFA number and password:

2. Start Registration

- a) Once logged in, select “Make a Registration” or “Register Now”
- b) Update contact details if necessary.
- c) On the next screen, enter the club name Cooroora United Football Club
NB: If you get a message saying there are no packages then click OK and check the club name
- d) Select the Registration role as: “Player”
NB: If this is the first time you have registered to play football in Australia you will need to confirm whether you played in another country
- e) Select the correct Registration Package that applies for your registration.
- f) Click the “Add” button.
- g) Click the Next button at the bottom of the screen.
- h) Read and acknowledge the Terms and Conditions then click Next.
- i) Click on “Pay Now” to pay online with a credit card (VISA or MasterCard), or select “Manual Payment at Club” if you want to pay at our club information day, via bank transfer, or to apply for Paysmart.
NB: Payment must be made before a registration can be accepted.
- j) Answer the questions on the final page and click the “Save All Answers” button.

Your registration has now been submitted. Make sure you have paid your fees and completed any necessary ID checks, etc.
